## DID YOU KNOW...

- ➡ DEPRESSION IS THE LEADING DISABILITY IN THE WORLD!
  - ➡ Every 13.7 minutes someone COMPLETES suicide and every 32 seconds someone ATTEMPTS suicide.
- **→** In 2010, 1,133 Georgians died by suicide, up 17% from 967 (2008).
- → Hospitalizations for suicide attempts between 2002 2006, (16,160 attempts) in Georgia resulted in \$20 million dollars in hospital charges. Now the rate of attempts per year has almost doubled and the medical costs have more than tripled.
  - Of 38,364 suicide deaths nationally in 2010, 30,277 were MEN.
  - **⇒ 80%** of all suicides, the person has told someone of their intention prior to taking their life. These are lives we can save!
- More armed service men and women have died by suicide than have died in this war. The suicide rate for active duty female soldiers has TRIPLED.
  - ➡ In a typical high school and middle school classroom in GA, on average 3 students have made a suicide attempt in the past year.
  - Adolescents who have lost a friend to suicide are almost 3 times more likely to complete suicide than those that have not.
    - → 28.1 % of gay or bisexual males in grades 7-12 have attempted suicide at least once during their lives.
- → More than 1 million adults nationally reported attempting suicide in the past year, with rates of attempted suicide lowest in Delware at 0.1% and highest in Georgia at 1.5%.
- **→** Suicide is the most preventable cause of death. Early Intervention is often the key.
  - In 2012, Suicide surpassed car accidents as the leading cause of injury-related death in the U.S.
